COVID-19 has added another layer of worry, concern and stress for children, parents and educators. Learn how to meet the needs of children so they can move forward to enhance Post Traumatic Growth. This includes strategies to provide emotional, social and cognitive support to promote resilience and post traumatic growth. It only takes one or two caring adults to impact a child's life. Use the principles of connecting, aspiring, rewiring and empowering to build individuals who can thrive in our ever-changing world.



1. Learn about areas of the brain that might have been impacted by COVID-19
